Deadline to Submit Nominations: November (the second Friday of the month)

NOTE: The candidate must be an HSACCC Regular member for at least five years.

How to Nominate a Candidate for HSACCC Exemplary Award:

- Submit a letter of recommendation for the candidate and a minimum of two letters of support.
- At least one recommendation must be from an HSACCC **Regular** member at an institution other than the one at which the nominee is employed. The individual nominating the candidate may **NOT** write a letter of support.
- Include a detailed explanation as to why the candidate should be considered for the HSACCC Exemplary Award.
- Provide evidence of the candidate's achievement in both of the following categories (candidates need not satisfy all criteria):
 1. Professional Achievements in College Health
 - Contributions to the advancement of knowledge in the field
 - Distinguished educational, professional, or administrative ability
 - Publication in professional journals
 - Service to employing institution(s)
 - Research activities
 - Recognition by other related organizations
 2. Service to HSACCC
 - Annual meeting participation (e.g., presentations, panels, program planning)
 - Service to the association (e.g., officer of the association)

- Regular attendance at HSACCC meetings
- Commitment/leadership in the field of college health, embodying the mission and goals of HSACCC while advancing the health of the campus community.
- Other outstanding service to HSACCC.

Once the nomination and support documentation packet has been received, the HSACCC Executive Board will review the documents and make its selection. The Recipient will be honored during HSACCC's Annual Meeting Recognition Dinner.
